

### IMPORTANT MESSAGE REGARDING TRACK AND TRACE

The Department for Education has issued the following guidance:

For the first 6 days after teaching ends, if a pupil or staff member tests positive for Covid-19, having developed symptoms within 48 hours of being in school, the school is asked to assist in identifying close contacts and advising self-isolation, as the individual may have been infectious whilst in school.
