READING GUIDE AND READING REWARD SCHEME

Please spend some time looking at our new Reading Guide which contains useful information and tips about reading at home with your child. We are hoping that this will help to keep reading fun and engaging. The reading reward scheme is going well and we have seen a marked improvement in the number of times the children are reading based on comments in their reading records. Please remember that your child can receive 2 tallies per day, including weekends (14 in total per week). When they reach 100 tallies, they will receive a free book. At the start of a half term or term (depending on the number of days available in order to make the 100 tallies achievable), the counting will begin again at zero.
