Dear Parents/Carers

The Spring Term is in full swing and it is great to see our pupils engaging so well in lessons and developing their skills across the curriculum. We have been managing staff absences with as little disruption as possible and we appreciate your support as always. We are all looking forward to lighter mornings and evenings with hopefully less restrictions on the horizon.

ATTENDANCE

Well done to **Class 1** for winning the fortnightly Attendance Award! Our whole school attendance is currently 95.8% which is above the national average. Thank you for helping us to maintain high rates of attendance. I am unable to authorise family holidays and would like to share the following information with you:

95% attendance	9.5 days that your child has been absent	Almost 2 weeks missed
90% attendance	19 days that your child has been absent	Almost 4 weeks missed
85% attendance	28.5 days that your child has been absent	Almost 6 weeks missed

90% attendance throughout your child's school life is equal to a whole year of school being missed.

Being frequently late to school adds up to lost learning:

- Arriving 5 minutes late every day adds up to around 3 days absence a year
- Arriving 15 minutes late every day adds up to around 2 weeks absence a year
- Arriving 30 minutes late every day adds up to around 4 weeks absence a year

I do not expect children to attend school when they are too poorly. I would be happy to discuss any issues you may have regarding attendance and look forward to hearing from you.
