The children did our school proud with their attitudes and exemplary behaviour throughout the whole trip. They had been looking forward to it for so long and there were some very tired children and staff spotted on Friday afternoon when they returned to school! Class three had a fantastic time at Bewerley Park last week! The children did four different activities which required them to face their fears, be brave and show resilience. We went to Brimham rocks where the children learned how to safely climb rocks, they played games such as 'the floor is lava' and squeezed between and under some of the rocks! We also went canoeing where the children learned all about the different parts of a canoe, how to paddle and control the canoe and they even had the opportunity to jump out and get wet! Then the children faced the leap of faith where they climbed a wooden pole which was over 8 metres high! The children leaped from the top of the pole to catch the bar - it really was scary. Finally, we went beck scrambling at Blayshaw where we made our way through the river, we slid down some natural slides and jumped into a freezing pool of water!
