Spelling Shed makes the acquisition of spelling and word knowledge fun and engaging for pupils. The scheme aligns with the English National Curriculum. There are fun games and activities to support pupils with their spellings.

MathShed

For pupils in Reception to Year 6

MathShed is designed to significantly impact the enjoyment of mathematics. It aims to make learning mathematics facts fun for students. There are lots of games and activities to support pupils with their learning.
