
TRIBUTE TO MRS PAM ROUNCE

I have some sad news to share with the school community. Mrs Pam Rounce, former Head Teacher of Appleton Wiske School, has passed away after a long battle with cancer. Mrs Hainsworth was a colleague and close friend of Pam's and has written the following tribute:

Pam initially came to Appleton Wiske as a teacher in Class 1 where she was the calmest, kindest and most patient teacher with the youngest children in the school. She inspired many children and adults over the years and children were so fortunate to have had Pam as their first teacher which meant they had the best start to school life ever. A few years later Pam became Head Teacher where she created a lovely, caring atmosphere across the whole school with everybody working and learning together. Visitors always commented on how approachable, friendly and positive Pam and her team made them feel. Pam was always a child at heart and her legacy lives on through the 'Pam Rounce Team Trophy' which is awarded every year in the final whole school celebration assembly.

Our whole school attendance is currently 95.95% which is below our target of 97%. Please remember that I am unable to authorise holidays.
