Duty of Care

The Head Teacher has a duty of care to ensure that all staff who provide activities have the following essential criteria to work in our school:

- DBS checked
- Competencies and attributes enabling them to deliver activities to groups of children from the ages of 4 to 11.
- Be a good role model for the children and a good communicator
- The Club Manager or designated member of staff takes the register for every after school club session

Communication

- In the event of cancellation, the Head Teacher or Club Manager will inform the parents in advance. If a club is cancelled at short notice, the Head Teacher will ensure that an alternative activity is available in order to prevent disruption for parents.
- If a parent does not collect their child on time, the Head Teacher or designated member of staff on cover duty will wait for a reasonable length of time and only after trying all telephone contacts, will contact social services.

Health & Safety

- Each activity organiser is responsible for the risk assessment for their own particular activity. It is the responsibility of the Head Teacher to review these termly to check for any changes required.
- The school hall, library, school fields, school playground and classrooms are venues for the activities, all of which have general risk assessments in place, produced by the school staff.
- All food is refrigerated and/or kept in sealed containers according to food hygiene regulations.
- At all times it is our policy that there is a qualified first aider on site for all before and after school clubs.

Visions, Values and Aims

The After School Club will function under the visions, values and aims of the school.

Inclusion and Equality

All paid activities are open to all children who attend the school, aged between 4 & 11 years of age. Pupil Premium funding is used to subsidise activities for eligible children.
